TED UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF ENGINEERING PRINCIPLES FOR RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

- 1. The course credit transfer process is carried out by the departments based on the priority order of the course in the curriculum.
- 2. Provided that the course meets the relevant program outcomes, credit transfer is carried out through document evaluation if the course has been taken from an English-medium formal education institution. The TED University credit system is taken as the basis in credit transfer. Credit transfer is applicable for courses with a minimum grade of 2.00/4.00 in the four-point grading system.
- 3. For courses to be credited through document evaluation, it is required to submit the course syllabi (including weekly content and learning outcomes), catalog descriptions, and an official transcript showing the grade obtained.
- 4. For the mandatory Higher Education Council (YÖK) courses "Atatürk's Principles and History of Reforms" and "Turkish Language," instruction in English is not required.
- 5. Based on the total credits of the transferred courses, necessary reductions in the maximum scholarship duration and student status duration are made in accordance with the relevant decisions of the TED University Senate and applicable regulations/guidelines.
- 6. In the evaluation of transfer applications, the relevant "YÖK framework regulation," "TED University Senate Principles for Transfer," and the "TED University Undergraduate Programs Transfer Directive" are taken as the basis.
